If you notice someone doing this, please make a note of the make, model, and color of the vehicle and get the license plate if you can. Call and report it so the sheriff's office can take care of it.

Neighborhood Garage Sale: I've had a few calls about the Neighborhood Garage Sale. This is an annual event and will be held the 2nd week of October. That date falls on Saturday, October 19th this year. Please mark your calendars!

Clubhouse Window: Last month, a window was broken in the clubhouse and it looked as if a rock had possibly been thrown at the window. If any of you are out and about near the Clubhouse, please check around it just to see if you notice anything out of the ordinary and notify someone on the board. Hopefully it was just an accident and nothing intentional.

Burning in Yards: Please remember that making fires and burning leaves, etc. in your front yard is not allowed.

Still Time to Pay Annual Dues and SAVE!!!

Remember that there are 2 payment options available for your Home Owner Dues; You can pay annually or quarterly. If you opt to pay in full for a 10% discount, your payment of \$189.97 is due by February 28th. You still have time to get that payment in! If you opt to pay quarterly, your 4 payments of \$52.77 are due February 28th, May 31st, August 31st, and November 30th.

New Orleans Brunch Cake

1 yellow cake mix - any brand

Coconut pecan frosting

1 stick margarine

4 eggs

12 oz. sour cream

Mix eggs and sour cream until smooth. Add cake mix, beat. Add frosting and melted margarine to cake batter and mix well.

Grease and flour tube (Bundt) pan. Bake 40 minutes @ 350 degrees or until toothpick comes out clean.

Turn cake out while hot. I let mine sit in tube pan for about five minutes before turning out. This is great with coffee in the morning.
