**HELPFUL INFORMATION ON KEEPING BUGS AWAY**

With mosquitoes out in full force, we need to remember to do our best to keep those pesky bugs away! I mention this each year, hoping it is a helpful tip to everyone. I have many of these plants and do believe they help keep bugs to a minimum on my patio. They are also a nice addition to the décor.

Chemical products aren't always the best choice, especially if you have any animals or small children. A few of the plants I mentioned that help keep bugs away last year are:

Citronella, Lemon Balm, Catnip, Marigold, Basil, Lavendar, Peppermint, Garlic, Rosemary, and Geraniums. You can always google them online for pictures and more information.

## Avocado Egg Salad

### INGREDIENTS

- 6 avocados - peeled, pitted, and cubed
- 1 teaspoon fresh lemon juice
- 5 hard-cooked eggs, chopped
- 1/2 red onion, minced
- 1/2 cup light mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon milk
- 3 hard-cooked eggs, sliced
- 1/2 teaspoon paprika

### DIRECTIONS

- Toss avocado cubes with lemon juice in a serving bowl;
- Mix avocado with chopped egg and onion.
- Whisk together the mayonnaise and milk; add to avocado mixture and gently mix.
- Arrange the remaining eggs sliced atop the salad in rows.
- Sprinkle top with paprika.

## Refreshing Fruit Salad

2 large apples (peeled or unpeeled)

3 bananas

8 - 10 strawberries

Grapes (any kind you like)

Oranges or tangelos

Blackberries

Blueberries

Pineapple—Any other fruit you want to toss in

### Toss together

Sprinkle 2 - 3 packages of splenda (amount depends on amount of fruit)

1/8 to 1/4 cup of Half & Half or Coffee Rich Non-Dairy Creamer

Toss again

Refrigerate & serve
