Texas Style Pulled Pork

Approximately 4 lbs of Pork Loin - lightly seasoned

Can add minced onions, garlic powder, but not necessary.

Put the pork loin in the crock pot and add

1 bottle of root beer per 2 lbs of pork loin

Turn on low for approximately 6—8 hours.

You can also cook this on low in the oven overnight or during the day

In oven, follow instructions above, cover the pot and cook on about 250 degrees for 6 - 8 hours.

When done, you can take the pork out, put barbecue sauce on it or just serve it with the juice from cooking. You can heat barbecue sauce on the side for some to add to their serving. You can also put the juice on the side to use on the pork.

Great with potato salad, make sandwiches, po-boys, etc.

*****NOTE*** Be sure to check your water bills very closely! Several residents have had issues this month with higher bills and late fees when they are NOT late.
