Firehouse Stew

1 1/2 lbs stew meat

1 lb down home sausage

2 lbs cubed new potatoes

1 Onion chopped

5 cans veggies (your choice)

1/4 cup small elbow macaroni

1 can stewed or Rotel tomatoes

Seasonings: Tony's, Garlic powder, black pepper, Cavender's Greek seasoning

Add seasonings to your taste

Flour stew meat and brown slightly in large Dutch oven in about 1/4 in oil

Add water about 1/2 way up the pot

Bring to a boil for about 5 min

Add onion and potatoes & cook until soft

Add veggies and tomatoes

Cook Macaroni and add to pot

Simmer for 2 hours stirring regularly to prevent sticking or put in large crock pot for 4 hours

Serves about 10

Please be aware that there is currently a SCAM going on concerning the IRS. People are receiving calls stating that you are under investigation and in danger of losing your home and much more unless you pay thousands of dollars on the spot. Victims have been swindled out of more than \$15 million since this began in 2013. Remember that you should NEVER provide any personal information over the phone to ANYONE unless you initiated the call! Never provide your SSN, Credit Card Number, or any other personal information to anyone that calls you. They may even have quite a bit of personal information on you but do NOT provide anything else to these callers. Should you receive a call of this nature, report it to the authorities immediately.

Please remember to call the Sheriff's Office at 318-965-2203 if you see something suspicious or out of the ordinary in the subdivision. We are a Neighborhood Watch Community and want to look out for one another.
