#### Sweet Potato Casserole

3 cups cooked, mashed sweet potatoes

2 eggs - beaten

1/3 cup evaporated milk

1 cup sugar

½ cup butter/margarine

1 tsp. vanilla extract



Mix ingredients & place in large, buttered, shallow baking dish.

Sprinkle with topping and Bake at 350 degrees for 25 minutes.

#### Topping

1 cup light brown sugar

1/3 cup butter/margarine softened

½ cup flour

1 cup chopped pecans (nuts)

Mix butter with flour & sugar using pastry blender or fingers. Add nuts, mix, and pour on top of casserole before baking.
