**Yummy Gooey Butter Cake**

**Ingredients:**

- |                                |       |                               |
|--------------------------------|-------|-------------------------------|
| 1 box yellow cake mix          | 1 egg | 1 bar oleo/butter (1st Three) |
| 1 package cream cheese (8 oz.) |       | 1 tsp. Vanilla flavoring      |
| 1 lb. Powdered sugar           |       | 2 eggs                        |

- Spray 9 x 13 Pyrex dish with pam (or similar spray)
- Mix the first 3 ingredients with a fork or pastry blender until crumbly. Put in the Pyrex dish
- In another bowl, mix the 4 last ingredients with a beater/mixer or by hand.
- Pour this mixture on top of the first mixture that is now in the pan.
- Bake at 350 degrees for 45-60 minutes.
