Delicious Homemade Chicken Soup

4 boneless skinless chicken breasts
2 cans Campbell's vegetable soup
1 can tomato sauce
1 can whole or diced tomatoes
Canned or fresh vegetables, if desired
4 potato's
Egg Noodles, macaroni, or whatever pasta you like

In a large pot, add your chicken breasts and fill water halfway.

Bring to a boil.

Turn heat to medium and let cook for 30 min.

Add all other ingredients except potatoes and noodles and cook on medium for 1.5 hrs

Add potatoes and cook for another 30 min

Start cooking your noodles.

Pour noodles in bowl and pour soup over. If you put them in the soup, they often fall apart.

Will take about 4 hrs all together

Blueberry Cobbler from Gisela

1 cup flour
1 cup milk
 $\frac{3}{4}$ to one cup sugar
Blueberries or any other fruit you like

Melt enough butter in a cake pan (in oven) to cover the bottom

Mix flour, milk, and sugar

Pour mixture over butter when melted

Pour fruit on top to cover the mixture

Bake until done

Bake for 30 minutes at 400 degrees then down 350 degrees for 30 more minutes. Watch it closely. When browning on top, it should be done. May need to go another 15 minutes - just use your judgment.
