## Elvis Presley Cake

### Ingredients:

- 1 (18.25 ounce) package white cake mix. Great Value Deluxe Moist White Cake Mix, 15.25 oz.
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple with juice.
- 2 cups white sugar.
- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese.
- ½ cup butter, softened.
- 4 cups confectioners' sugar.
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract.
- 1 cup chopped pecans.

### Directions:

- Prepare cake according to instructions on package. Bake in a 9x13 inch pan. Allow to cool.
  - Combine pineapple and sugar in saucepan. Bring to a boil. Spoon over cooled cake.
  - In a large bowl, cream butter and cream cheese until smooth. Add powdered sugar and beat until smooth. Add vanilla. Add pecans and mix well.
  - Spread cream cheese frosting over cake.

## Praline Cake

### Ingredients:

- |   |                         |
|---|-------------------------|
| • 1 stick melted butter                   | 1 cup light brown sugar |
| • 4 tablespoons light corn syrup          | 2 cups chopped pecans   |
| • 1-15 ounce box of butter pecan cake mix | 1 ¼ cups water          |
| • 1/3 cup oil                             | 3 eggs                  |

### Directions:

- Preheat oven to 325 degrees.
- Spray a 9" x 13" baking pan with cooking spray.
- Mix the first four ingredients together in a small bowl.
- Spread pecan mixture into the bottom of the pan.
- Prepare cake mix according to the box directions.
- Pour cake batter on top of the pecan mixture.
- Bake for 45 minutes.
- When done, remove from oven and flip onto cake plate.
- Leave the cake pan over the cake for 5 minutes.
- After 5 minutes, remove the pan and serve. Yields about 12 servings.
