POOL PASSES FOR SALE AT SPRING FLING

Pool Passes can be purchased at the Spring Fling! Passes will be \$80 for a family up to 5 members and \$40 to purchase a single pass. Credit Cards cannot be accepted for Pool Passes. Only cash or checks can be used for Pool Passes. Prices will remain the same for pool passes all summer.

After Spring Fling, in order to purchase pool passes, you will need to contact the Pool Manager, Shannon Mitchell, to see when she could meet you to get passes.

We are looking for lifeguards and attendants for the pool this summer. You must be at least 16 years old with a Lifeguard Certification or 18 years old with CPR Certification. **Also, you do NOT have to live in Country Place to be a lifeguard. Please remember that HOA dues must be current in order to purchase pool passes, rent the clubhouse or rent the pool for a party.

CPR Classes Can be Arranged for Lifeguards and Attendants

CPR classes can be arranged for any lifeguards and attendants needing the certification. Please contact Shannon Mitchell if you are interested. We need to have the CPR class done by the middle of May to be ready for the opening of the pool. The class is FREE but there is a \$10 cost for the CPR Card, once certified. The class would be held at the clubhouse.

Quick Cheesy Bread

Ingredients:

1 ½ cups warm water
¼ tsp sugar
2 ¼ tsp rapid yeast (1 packet)
3 cups AP flour
1 tsp salt
2 cups cheddar cheese (or your choice)
Optional - Garlic Powder and/or onion Powder

Directions:

Combine everything in one bowl.
Mix to combine.
On floured counter or board, fold into a ball.
In an oiled bowl, cover the ball with plastic wrap and a towel.
Let it rise for 1 to 1 ½ hours. (place in unheated oven to rise.)
When it is double in size, remove from the oven and preheat to 450 degrees.
Place dough on a large piece of parchment paper.
Place a Dutch Oven into heating oven for 10 minutes to warm it.
Put the bread in the Dutch oven and cover.
Bake for 25-30 minutes.
Remove cover & broil for 5 minutes to brown.
Remove from oven and cool.

Hot Crawfish Dip

Ingredients:

16 ounces cooked crawfish tails
¾ cup butter
1 10 oz. can cream of mushroom soup
2 bunches finely chopped green onions
1 Tbsp. chopped garlic
Salt & Pepper or season to taste
About 3 Tbsp. dried parsley

Directions:

In a large skillet, sauté onions in butter until soft.
Once soft, add all remaining ingredients.
Heat thoroughly, stirring now and then.
Put in a chafing dish and serve with chips or crackers.
